Background

As the market for the UK nuclear industry supply chain continues to evolve, the need for better understanding, sharing best practice and communication remains vital. The Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA) is producing a prioritised strategy for decommissioning and clean-up. Both Sellafield and Dounreay have been identified as priority sites. Alongside this, competition for Parent Body Organisations (PBO) to run the Site Licence Company contracts has also begun, providing innovative and strategic direction.

For defence sites, a network of management contracts has been established covering both operational sites, such as AWE, and those sites being decommissioned. The long term opportunities of these decisions could affect all tiers of the supply chain. This SAFESPUR event will provide the opportunity for contractors, consultants, practitioners and those working on land management and decommissioning projects to hear about the future plans.

- Hear about the latest current projects from the NDA directed to different sites or groups and for Dounreay and Sellafield sites.
- Hear from the Trawsfynydd Commercial Team regarding the site's Near Term Work Plan and the associated procurement processes.
